Web There are 2 main types of kidney (renal) failure: acute (sudden) and chronic (over time) Acute Renal Failure – more commonly known today as “acute kidney injury” (AKI) AKI occurs when the kidneys suddenly stop filtering waste products from the blood The signs of AKI can be: swelling of the hands, feet and face (edema) internal bleeding confusion
