#### **View audit log reports - Microsoft Support**

You can use the audit log reports provided with SharePoint to view the data in the audit logs for a site collection You can sort, filter, and analyze this

data to determine who has done what with sites, lists, libraries, content types, list items, and library files in the site collection For example, you can determine who deleted which content
